## EN CASO DE REDADAS

### NO ABRA LA PUERTA

- Pídale al agente que le muestre una orden judicial por la ventana o debajo de la puerta y asegúrese que sea una orden judicial válida.
- Una orden judicial válida debe tener: su nombre, dirección correcta, fecha vigente y estar firmada por un juez.
- Si la orden judicial tiene información incorrecta, la orden NO es válida. Muestrale al agente este volante por debajo de la puerta o ventana.

### PERMANEZCA EN SILENCIO

- No conteste ninguna pregunta y diga: "I wish to remain silent".
- Si habla después de invocar este derecho, debe decir "I wish to remain silent" nuevamente para proteger sus derechos.
- No dé información acerca de dónde nació, o cómo llegó al país.

### HABLE CON SU ABOGADO

- Diga "I will call my attorney" y háblele a su abogado antes de contestar cualquier pregunta.

### NO FIRME NADA

- No firme ningún documento.

"Salaries and Expenses Immigration and Customs Enforcement" including the expense of an attendant if necessary.

**EJEMPLO DE UNA ORDEN JUDICIAL:**

Debe tener nombre y direccion correcta, fecha vigente y estar firmada por un juez.

The United States of America, having filed an application to authorize officers of United States Immigration and Customs without legal authority and, if any such persons are found on the premises, to exercise their authority pursuant to section 287 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, 8 U.S.C. § 1357, to question them to determine whether they are such aliens and, if there is probable cause to believe they are such aliens, to arrest them.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement shall conduct the entry and search during daylight hours with ten (10) days of the issuance of this warrant, and make its return to this Court with ten (10) days of the date the entry and search have been completed.
